Drainage area. --Not measured. Records available. --November 9, 1912, to June 30, 1914. Gage. --Vertical staff on left bank. Discharge measurements. --Made by wading or from footbridge. Channel and control. --Gravel and mud; likely to shift; during very high stages water overflows both banks. Extremes of discharge. --Maximum stage recorded during year, 3. 68 feet at 2. 30 p. m. April 24 (discharge, 71 second-feet); minimum stage recorded, 0. 63 foot February 6 (discharge, 0. 8 second-foot). Winter flow. --Discharge relation not affected by ice.
