It occurs in the diffuse form, or as gummata, frequently associated with myocarditis. The latter was found as diffuse interstitial affection, or in the form of gummous deposits. Interstitial myocarditis more frequently attacks the walls and muscles of the left of the heart than of the right. The endocardium usually shows a bluish-white colour, is often thickened, but in an unequal manner; the original tissue of the muscles disappears and gets replaced by a dense fibrous whitish substance, interspersed with yellow spots. Effusion of serum into the pericardium seems rarer than in other heart diseases. Eight cases of gummata of the heart are recorded in medical literature. The little tumours are liable to soften, and may produce ulceration of the heart and embolism (Oppolzer). The symptoms...
